

C6 FULL ENGINE SHROUD PLENUM COVER

PART # 50338

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please note this is a hand formed piece and may require some additional shaping by hand in order to achieve a nice snug fit. DO NOT be afraid to bend, push or force your shroud into position.

CAUTION Use soft cloth gloves for installation. Edges of metal are very thin and may cause injury if installed without adequate hand protection. If you have purchased the alternator cover also, do not install it until this cover is installed first.

Parts Included: 2-self-tapping screws, chrome oil cap cover, Velcro attachment cookie, butal putty and a triangular fuel line cover.

Your new cover comes to you with a protective liner. Do not remove liner until step 4.

1. Remove the oil fill cap.
2. Slightly nudge dipstick tube away from engine.
3. Starting at the drivers side slide the new cover over the braided fuel line until it reaches the triangular opening. Then set over oil filler area.
4. You have been provided with 2-self tapping screws. Using a screw gun set the screws directly into the front of the factory fuel rail cover at the two brackets, just under your new cover. Make sure to press downward on the cover so that the cover is completely seated on top of the factory fuel rail covers. This will create adequate hood clearance. Your new engine shroud comes to you preformed however it will be necessary to tweek its overall shape so that it hugs the engine snugly. Once attached remove the protective liner.
5. Replace the oil filler cap and attach the chrome oil cap cover (provided) via the Velcro attachment cookie (provided). Due this by simply wiping the top of your factory oil filler cap with household rubbing alcohol. Then remove Velcro liner and attach. Finally you have been provided with a triangular fuel line cover. This cover can be permanently silicone into position using clear household silicone or if you prefer you may rely on the attachment butal putty provided by simply pressing into position.

Note: Care must be taken when cleaning your cover. It is a good idea to lightly dust your cover with a clean soft cloth first in order to prevent any particles from scratching it. Then wipe (using a new clean soft cloth) with a good quality streak free glass cleaner.
