

FENDER STRIPES

Read entire instructions before starting!

1. Lay decal into position on the car so you have an idea where it will go.



2. Spray the work area with application fluid (4 drops detergent to 1 pint of water), then separate the decal from the paper and spray the back (tacky side) of the decal.



3. Apply the decal starting with the alignment tags from the top of the headlight as shown.

4. Next, with your hand, press down the top 2 inches of the decal to the body of the fender. DO NOT try to apply the entire decal. Take the squeegee (credit card will work okay) and apply it to the area you just pressed with your hand then apply it to the rest of the decal. When the stripes are in place, remove the transfer tape. When the stripes are in place, remove the transfer tape without pulling up the stripes. If the stripes start to come off, squeegee back in place and let the decals dry a few minutes longer.



5. Once you have removed the tape you can remove the alignment tags from the fender of the car.



6. Use a squeegee to remove any bubbles of fluid under the decal. If you have some small bubbles that you cannot remove don't worry, the decal does breathe and the fluid will evaporate after a couple of days. If it is a must that you have the bubbles removed you can use a pin to puncture the decal and squeeze out the fluid.
